hometown	City where you were born	My hometown is Paris
hobby	Activity you enjoy doing	Reading is my hobby
family	Parents, siblings, relatives	I have a small family
nationality	Country you are from	My nationality is American
student	Person who studies	I am a student
married	Having a husband or wife	I am married to Sarah
single	Not married	I am single
live	Have your home somewhere	I live in London
work	Have a job	I work at a bank
study	Learn at school	I study English
come from	Be from a place	I come from Italy

■ Key Phrases

My name is... → My name is... | **I'm from...** → I'm from... | **I work as...** → I work as... | **I live in...** → I live in... | **Nice to meet you** → Nice to meet you | **I'm ... years old** → I'm ... years old

■ Grammar Rules

1. Use 'I am' for identity: Use 'I am' to say who you are. You can contract it to 'I'm' in casual conversation.
2. Articles with jobs: Use 'a' or 'an' before job titles. Use 'an' before vowel sounds (a, e, i, o, u).
3. Present simple for facts: Use present simple to talk about permanent things. Don't add -s with 'I'.
4. Question formation: Start questions with question words. Use 'What' for things, 'Where' for places.
5. Prepositions with places: Use 'from' for origin, 'in' for current location. These are fixed combinations.
6. Polite responses: Always respond politely to introductions. Use 'too' to return the same greeting.
